PRWA Board of Directors Expectations



The Pennsylvania Rural Water Association Board has identified a list of expectations that candidates for the Board of Directors must consider in order to fully carry out the duties as a Board Member and represent the small and rural systems of Pennsylvania.



Candidate Expectations:

- 1 Be an operator, manager, or decision maker of a PRWA voting member (serving 15,000 or less population) in good standing.
- 2 Attend a minimum of four regularly scheduled Board of Directors meetings; these meetings are held in Centre County.
- 3 Attend assigned committee meetings (minimum of four per year).
- 4 Attend PRWA's Annual Conference (normally scheduled near the end of March).
- 5 Submit a signed letter from your system Board of Directors supporting your nomination for the Board of Directors and approving the level of commitment and the efforts required as a PRWA Board Member.
- 6 Represent PRWA at Washington D.C. Rural Water Rally and / or the NRWA Annual Conference.
- 8 Actively pursue the retention and recruitment of system and associate membership.
- 9 Represent PRWA at various functions, organization conferences (i.e.: AWWA, WWAOP, PMAA, WEF) and statewide committees.
- 10 Maintain the ethical and professional standards of PRWA.

Note: Time Contribution as a Board Member could exceed a total of 15 working days per year.
